## **Job Description:**

Seasonal Naturalists work with the Clayton County Naturalists on a wide variety of environmental education programs. Duties include leading tours, hikes, and other activities with visiting school groups; designing and constructing nature center displays; developing new educational activities; writing articles for the county conservation newsletter; assisting with the Junior Naturalist Program, a summer campout program for junior high students; monitoring bluebird boxes; and developing programs.

## **Qualifications:**

Applicants should have some course work in biology, ecology or natural sciences. Courses in environmental education, interpretation, or outdoor recreation would be beneficial, but are not required. Applicants should have the ability to work with people of all ages, and communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

## **Salary and Work Dates:**

\$7.25 per hour, 40 hours per week. Some weekend and night hours are required. Positions begin in May 2012 and will run 14 weeks.
