Hiking Responsibly

• Stay off of soft trails when wet

• Clayton County Parks allow foraging of only fruits, nuts, berries, mushrooms, and asparagus. Harvesting of plant parts from native species not permitted.

- Practice leave no trace—pack out trash, take only pictures, leave only footprints.
- Share the trail—hikers yield to horses and other pack animals on multi-use trails. In winter, hike adjacent to groomed or ski trails.
- Observe park regulations—all county parks open until 10:30 PM
- Wear high-visibility clothing in hunting areas
